

Deferred Self-Pledges for Road Hockey Captains

Game day is here and you still need to reach the \$10,000 fundraising minimum? Complete a deferred self-pledge to secure your spot at the event and give your team a little bit of fundraising overtime.

How it works:

- 1. When checking in online, choose "Deferred Self-Pledge".
- 2. Provide your credit card information to extend your fundraising deadline to secure your spot at the event.
- 3. Once your credit card information has been verified, your fundraising deadline will be extended until December 1, 2023.
- 4. If by December 1 your fundraising total equals or exceeds the \$10,000 minimum, your credit card will not be charged.
- 5. If by December 1 your fundraising total is still less than the required \$10,000 minimum, Road Hockey to Conquer Cancer will charge your credit card to cover the balance.

Here's an example of how it works.

Let's say your team raises \$8,000 but the minimum to play on September 30 is \$10,000. You (as a captain) can choose to make a deferred self-pledge. This will extend your team's fundraising deadline to December 1 and allow you to play on game day.

Scenario A: By December 1 your team's total has increased to \$10,000 (or more), your credit card will not be charged.

Scenario B: By December 1 your team's total has increased to \$9,000. A remarkable number but just shy of the required minimum. Road Hockey will charge your credit card \$1,000 to cover the balance.

Note: The Road Hockey Team will contact you directly before the transaction is made and confirm tax receipt details.
