WENDEL CLARK

Clark was drafted first overall by the Toronto Maple Leafs in the 1985 NHL Entry Draft. Other teams include New York Islanders, Tampa Bay Lightning, Detroit Red Wings, Chicago Blackhawks.



SHAYNE CORSON

Corson is a Canadian former professional hockey player who played in the NHL for the Montreal Canadiens, Edmonton Oilers, St. Louis Blues, Toronto Maple Leafs, and Dallas Stars.



TOM FERGUS

Fergus was drafted in the 3rd round of the 1980 NHL entry draft by the Boston Bruins. He amassed career totals of 235 goals and 346 assists for 581 points in 726 NHL games.



MATT DEAN PETTIT

Pettit is a Chef and Television Personality, regularly appearing on Cityline, CTV Your Morning and The Social, and a two-time award winning author.



COLETTE KENNEDY

Kennedy is an award winning meteorologist who came to CBC Weather Centre in 2013 and is now the number one sought after meteorologist in the country.



JEREMY ROENICK

Drafted eighth overall by the Chicago Blackhawks in the 1988 NHL Entry Draft. Other teams Phoenix Coyotes, Philadelphia Flyers, Los Angeles Kings, San Jose Sharks.



NICK KYPREOS

Kypreos is a Canadian former professional ice hockey left winger who played eight seasons in the NHL for the, Washington Capitals, New York Rangers and Toronto Maple Leafs.



MIKE KRUSHELNSKY

Krushelnyski played 14 years in the NHL. He won three Stanley Cups as a player with the Edmonton Oilers and one as an Assistant Coach with the Detroit Red Wings.



CARLO COLAIACOVO

Colaiacovo was drafted 17th overall by the Toronto Maple Leafs in the 2001 NHL Entry Draft and is currently co-hosting a show on Canada's TSN 1050 radio station.



IAN D'SA

Ian D'Sa is a Canadian guitarist and producer best known as a member of the rock band Billy Talent.



PAUL COFFEY

Coffey played for nine teams in the NHL. Known for his speed and scoring prowess, Coffey ranks second all-time among NHL defencemen in goals, assists, and points.



DAVE MCLLWAIN

McLlwain is a Canadian former professional ice hockey player. McLlwain is best known for playing for a record four National Hockey League teams in one season during the 1991-92 season.



ANDRE ROY

Roy was drafted by the Boston Bruins in the sixth round of the 1994 NHL Entry Draft and has also played for the Ottawa Senators, Tampa Bay Lightning, Pittsburgh Penguins, Calgary Flames.

LAURA FORTINO

Langlois is a Canadian musician, local from Kingston and guitarist for the popular Canadian band, The Tragically Hip.



DENNIS MARUK

Maruk is a Canadian former professional ice hockey player. He played in the NHL from 1975 to 1989, scoring a career-high 60 goals for the Washington Capitals in 1981-82.



KEN REID

Reid is the co-anchor of Sportsnet Central on Sportsnet. He has covered the Olympics, the Super Bowl, multiple Grey Cups, and has appeared on Hockey Night in Canada.



GERALDINE HEANEY

Heaney is an Irish-Canadian ice hockey coach and former defenceman. She played 18 seasons and over 1,000 games with the Toronto Aeros organization.



BRITTANY HOWARD

Howard is a Canadian ice hockey player. She played for the Robert Morris University Colonials women's ice hockey team, and was the first Colonial player to win the CHA Player of the Year Award.



JOHN LECLAIR

LeClair was drafted to the Montreal Canadiens immediately out of school. He played 16 seasons in the NHL with the Montreal Canadiens, Philadelphia Flyers, and Pittsburgh Penguins.



JAYNA HEFFORD

Jayna Hefford is a Canadian retired ice hockey player. During her career, she won 4 Olympic Gold medals and 1 Silver at the Winter Olympics and multiple IIHF World Women's Championships."



AL IAFRATE

Iafate is an American former professional ice hockey defenseman who played in the NHL between 1984 and 1998. He is perhaps most famous for his extremely hard slapshot.



DWIGHT DRUMMOND

Drummond is a Canadian television journalist, currently working as the anchor of CBC Toronto News with Dwight Drummond at CBLT, CBC in Toronto.
